

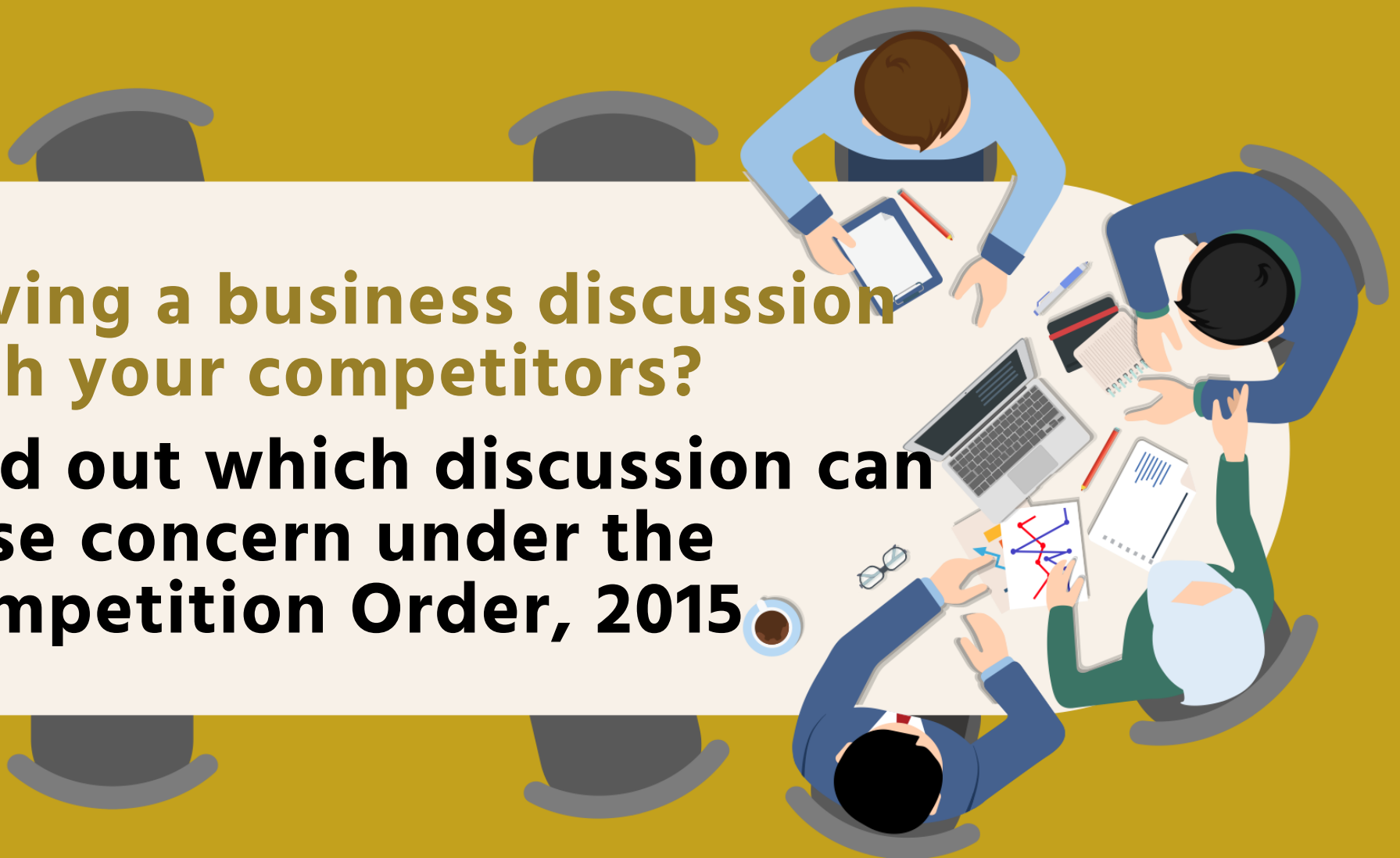

## » Discussion to limit supply

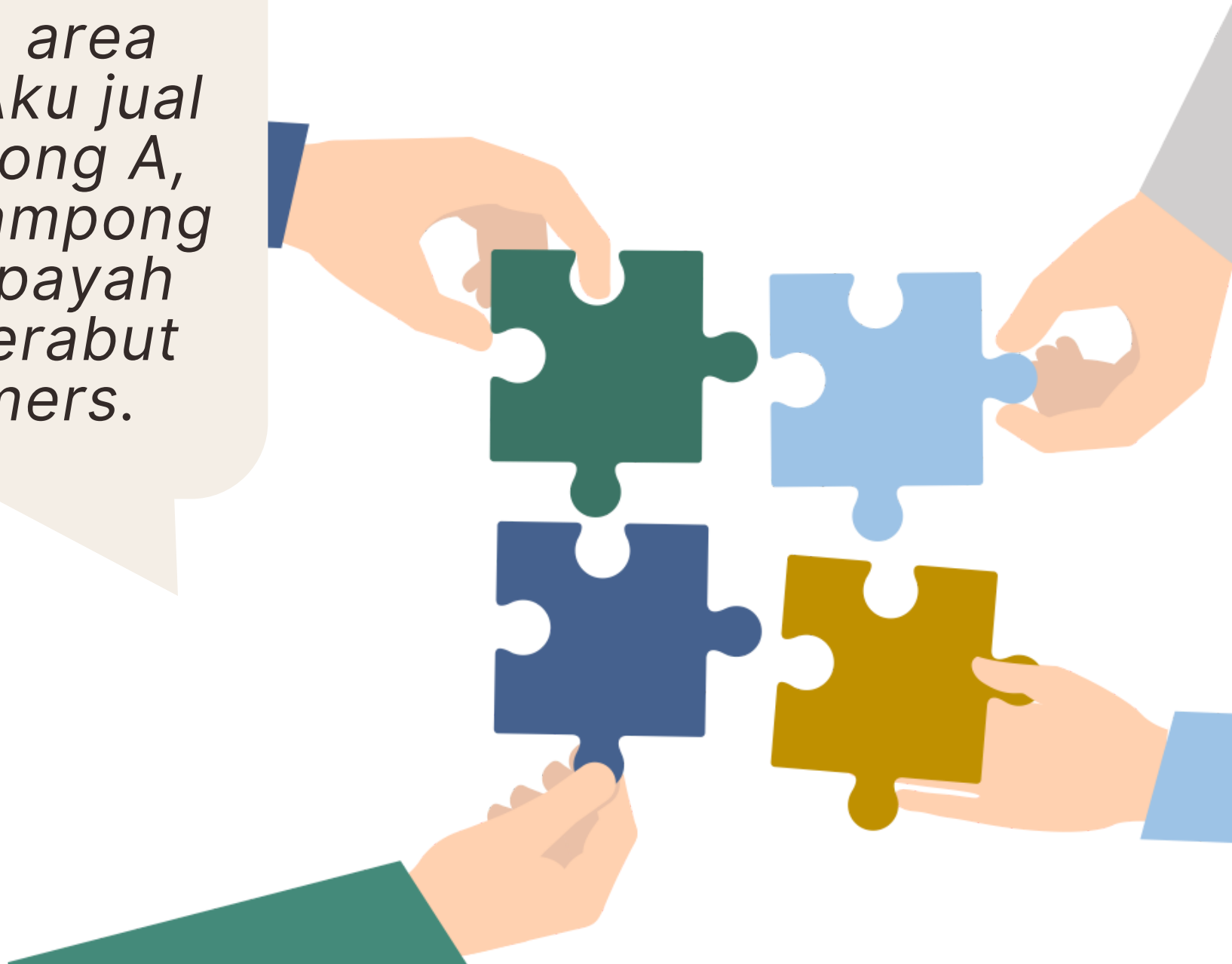
*Ji, mau limitkan saja total kuantiti jualan produk kitani? Biar harga produk yang kitani jual makin naik.*

Here are what you should do if you find yourself in an anti-competitive agreement discussion with your competitors:

- End the discussion immediately
- Distance yourself from such discussion
- Make clear of your disagreement
